# Possible Shutdown Assistance to EPA Staff and SEE Enrollees

To be prepared for a government shutdown (in either November or January 2024), the EPA Alumni Association is continuing its contingency planning to ensure we can support Agency staff and EPA SEE enrollees in accordance with federal ethics requirements. (See current federal ethics rules below). We want to support staff and EPA SEE enrollees who are having problems putting food on their table or purchasing essential medications.

In 2019, the Association supported EPA Staff and EPA SEE enrollees during the shutdown which resulted in 280 Alumni giving gifts with a value of \$36,500 to 165 EPA employees and SEE enrollees.

We are meeting with EPA, developing Fact Sheets, procedures, and a web site with links for potential Alumni donors and EPA staff and EPA SEE enrollees to sign up. The web site will be operational the day after the shutdown begins, and the link will be www.epaalumni.com/shutdown.

We are anxious to identify members ahead of time who are willing to be in the initial group of donors to send gift cards to needy EPA employees, should a prolonged shutdown occur. Almost 40 of you have already signed up, but we would like to have a larger group of initial donors. If you believe you will be able to help, please click the link below.

#### **Current Federal Ethics Rules**

Federal employees cannot accept any gift of cash or cash equivalents (currency, bank check, Venmo or Zelle transfer, etc.). Federal employees can accept a gift with a *value* of \$20 or less, excluding cash, from any one source such as a store gift or e-gift store card (Safeway, Albertsons, Walgreens, etc.) or other items with a value of \$20 or less\*.

\*The Federal ethics rules allow an unsolicited gift of \$20 or less per occasion and no more than \$50 in a calendar year from one person.

EPA is sharing some exciting news that may be of interest to our Members. EPA is pleased to announce the launch of EPA's "My


